



Note for 4h




Note for 10h


The verse can be played in the high octave of your harmonica, although you might find it a little shrill. The alternative is to play in the middle octave, but you will need to learn to draw bend hole 3". Your Harp Academy teacher will tell you more about this advanced key skill.


