### Note for 4h

### Note for 10h

The verse can be played in the **high octave** of your harmonica, although you might find it a little shrill. The alternative is to play in the **middle octave**, but you will need to learn to draw bend hole 3". Your Harp Academy teacher will tell you more about this advanced key skill.
