















Musical Alphabet 2

Here are the notes of the **C major scale**.



Placing the notes on lines and spaces makes them easier to read. The lines and spaces are called a **stave**. The curly symbol at the start of the stave is called the **treble clef**. For piano players, this is the right hand. It plays the notes from **middle C** upwards to the highest end of the keyboard.
